- Yfoundations and its Youth Homelessness Representative Council has held 3 meetings and produced 3 papers. These meetings were sponsored by corporate partners and the meeting held in July was attended by Minister Ward and Alex Greenwich MP.
- Yfoundations restructured to focus on members and produce documentation and information that supported the work of members.

We look forward to continuing to work with Zoe in her new role in Department of Premier and Cabinet and we know that she will continue to advocate for young people experiencing homelessness and for the young people of NSW.
